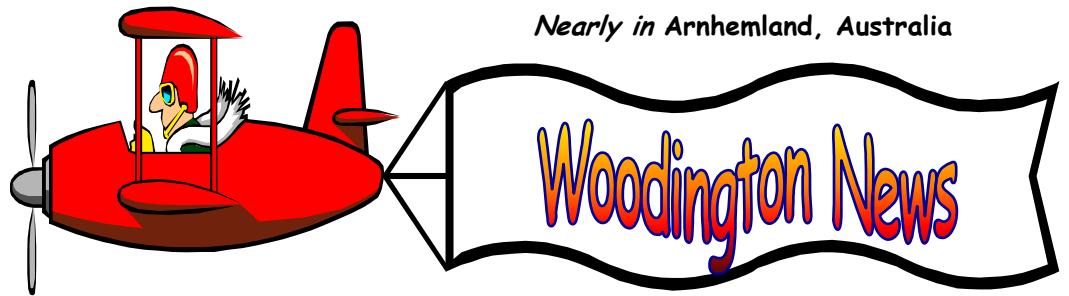


Nearly in Arnhemland, Australia
